Swim Munster General Meet Conditions

	General Meet Conditions	
Entries:	All entries for Swim Munster Meets must be submitted using Hy-Tek Team Manager software (except for Swim Munster Schools Championships). Electronic entries must be sent as an email attachment to <u>munsterentries@swimireland.ie</u> and should include an entry report, fee entry report and completed Summary Sheet. The Swim Ireland Registration number or equivalent for each swimmer must be included in the file.	
	 Entries can be rejected for the following reasons: Incorrectly completed No Entry Time submitted Received after the closing date. 	
	The Munster Recorder reserves the right to limit entries and merge events where numbers allow. If entries are rejected, the entry fee will be refunded, and a single payment will be made to the Club in question. The Swim Munster Entries will email confirmation of accepted entries after they are received, and it is the responsibility of the Club's Gala Secretary / Coach to check these entries as no changes / additional entries can be made on the day of the Gala.	
	The Club must pay for all entries that are on the Entry Report at the Cut Off Time for withdrawals – this is normally 12 midday the Friday before the event. No refunds / credits will be made for withdrawals after this time other than in exceptional circumstances or unless supported by a medical certificate.	
Volunteer Rotas:	Volunteer Rota positions are assigned to Clubs based on the number of entries from each Club as at the closing date of the event. To ensure the smooth running of all Swim Munster events parents are encouraged to volunteer as an official when their child is competing. It is a Munster requirement that all participating Clubs will provide 1:6 (One official for every 6 swimmers) up to a maximum of 4 officials per session at all events.	
Fitness to Compete:	Parents / Coaches must ensure that their swimmer is fit to compete in the Meet. If a swimmer must retire from a race or has to be removed from the water due to being unwell, for safety reasons Swim Munster will withdraw that swimmer from the remainder of the Meet (No fine will be imposed in such cases). Coaches should also ensure that swimmers are 'swim fit' and capable of undertaking the stroke and distance for which they are entered.	
Relay Sheets:	Relay Sheets are to be submitted to the Meet Director one hour prior to the start of the session in which the relay takes place.	
Age Up Date:	The age up date will always be 31 st December in the year of competition unless otherwise specified.	
Tech Suit Policy:	We ask clubs to ensure coaches, parents and athletes are fully aware of the Swim Ireland Tech Suit Policy so that we avoid any negative experiences on poolside. Full details of the policy can be found on the Swim Ireland website <u>https://www.swimireland.ie/news/swim-ireland-tech-suit-policy-2020</u>	



Awards:	Swimmers must ensure that they are suitably clothed (Club t-shirt and shorts or tracksuit) when receiving awards. It is the responsibility of the Coach / Team Manager to ensure that medallists or a deputy be available for presentation as per the presentation schedule, as applicable.
Starts:	Over the top starts will be used. If time constraints permit, the pool will be cleared for each final in Championship events. Side by Side starts in Backstroke events will be used, when required, to comply with time constraints.
Seeding:	 Preliminary Heats – unless specifically stated in the meet conditions, the placing of competitors in the heats will be multi-age, spearheaded and swum slowest to fastest. Heat Declared Winner Events – All heats will be multi-age, spearheaded and swum slowest heats to fastest. Finals – Finalists will be allocated lanes using the spearhead principal from the results of the heats.
Session Times:	The session times on all Meet Conditions are provisional. Session timing will be finalised once all entries have been processed and swimmers / clubs will be notified accordingly. Please note that it is the swimmers' responsibility to present themselves, ready to swim, at the marshalling area in good time prior to the start of the event.
Withdrawals:	 Please refer to individual Meet Conditions for instructions re withdrawals from particular events. As a general rule of thumb, withdrawals will be requested by 5pm on the evening before the meet. In the case of Championship events, withdrawals will be requested by 5pm on evening before 1st day and by 6pm on the evening before subsequent days. In the case of withdrawals from Finals at Championship events, an announcement will be made detailing those who have qualified for finals and will also name the two reserves. Swimmers will have 30 minutes from the time of the announcement to withdraw from finals. However, please check individual Meet Conditions for instructions particular to each Meet.
Meet Results:	Meet results will be posted on the Swim Munster website within approximately 72 hours of the end of the gala. Results will also be passed to Swim Ireland for their reference and inclusion in rankings. A Hy-Tek and PDF version of the results will also be sent to the registered Gala Secretary of each Club.
Age Criteria:	 All meets (other than school's competitions or Inter/Intra Club Galas) to be aged up to 31st December in the year of competition. The plan follows a sequential swimming development model in age bands as follows: Intra-Club Galas from 7 years upwards Inter-Club Galas from 8 years upwards Schools Competitions (aged up to 31st August) from 9 years upwards Club Open Meets from 9 years upwards Regional Future Challenger Series for athletes aged 10 to 14 years Regional Aspiring Champions Series for athletes aged 13 & over Regional SC Championships, National Meets/Championships from 13 years upwards Irish Summer National Age Group Championships from 15 years upwards



Photography:	It is a condition of attending a Swim Ireland event that swimmers accept they may be photographed or filmed as part of the occasion, either as an individual or as a member of a group. Swimmers may also appear in a photograph or video inadvertently. Parents and swimmers must accept this. All photography and/or filming must be in accordance with Swim Ireland Guidelines.
	Photographs cannot be taken at a Swim Ireland Munster event without first having registered the photographer and device at the administration desk. At some events, photography and filming may not be permitted at all.

Qualification Period:	Not applicable

Name:	Regional Aspiring Champions Series (athletes aged 13 & over)
Qualification Criteria:	 Athletes aged 13/14 years competing in the Future Challenger Series will not be eligible to compete in the Aspiring Champions Series in the same cycle. No consideration standards will be published for the 50/100/200m events however consideration standards will be published for the 400/800/1500m events. Club time trial results, signed off by the Head Coach, can be accepted for entry into the 400/800/1500m events. The number of individual entries permitted will be specified in the meet conditions.
Qualification Period:	For Short Course Meet, qualification period starts on 1 st September 2022. For Long
	Course Meet, it will be May 1 st , 2023.

Entries:	 No consideration standards will be published for athletes to swim up events however we do provide the following guidance to support entry decisions: 1. Athletes should be capable of executing the stroke legally 2. Athletes should be capable of executing good turns and good streamlining 3. 12-year-old athletes entering the 400m Freestyle should be capable of even pacing a 200m Freestyle within the 12-year-old consideration standard published for the Regional Age Group & Senior LC Championships Athletes should only enter events on the recommendation from their coach. Athletes may only compete in their own Region.



	Unless otherwise stated in the meet conditions athletes can enter as many individual events as deemed appropriate by their coach. Athletes may swim up or down distances as outlined in the Order of Events if their coach believes this is the appropriate distance for them, and athletes are limited to 1 distance per stroke per meet. Clubs can enter multiple relay teams.
	The Future Challenger Series is open to all competitive members aged 10 to 12 years however athletes aged 13/14 years may enter if they have not previously competed at the Aspiring Champions level or above and cannot compete at the Aspiring Champions Series in the same cycle i.e., the short course or long course season.
	Athletes with a disability must be registered as members of a Swim Ireland affiliated club at the time of entry.

	The gala will be run in Short Course (25m) Format at the 10 Lane Olympic Pool at UL Sport Arena, University of Limerick. This gala will be a fully licenced Swim Munster Gala and all participants will be covered by Swim Ireland Insurance.
Entries:	This season, it is planned to introduce an online system when swimmers can make their entries (individual and relays). This will be supported by Clubs who will submit entries for their own members. These entries will then be sent to the school for review and correction. The closing date for entries is 29 th September. Where possible all entries for a school should be submitted together.
	The school have final say in reviewing and correcting entries.
Events:	The Age Up Date for this gala is 31 st August 2024.
	Group $1 - 9 - Born 1^{st}$ September 2014 to 31^{st} August 2015 Group $2 - 10 - Born 1^{st}$ September 2013 to 31^{st} August 2014 Group $3 - 11 - Born 1^{st}$ September 2012 to 31^{st} August 2013 Group $4 - 12 - Born 1^{st}$ September 2011 to 31^{st} August 2012
	50m Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly, Freestyle (Groups 1-4) 100m Individual Medley (Groups 3 & 4). A swimmer can swim a maximum of 2 individual events.
	Relays – 4 x 50 Free & Medley Team Relays (9/10yrs, 9-12yrs) Swimmers may swim in an older age group but at least one team member must be in the correct age group. A swimmer can swim a maximum of 2 relays – these do not need to be in the same age group.
Awards:	Medals will be awarded for 1 st , 2 nd & 3 rd Place in each Age Group.
Entry Fee:	 €7 per individual event €20 per relay event
Officials:	To ensure the smooth running of the event each school MUST provide officials for each session to help with timekeeping / turn judge - where a school has more than 10 swimmers that school may be asked to provide more officials.
	Swim Munster will provide the key officials for each session. Swim Munster will circulate an Officials Roster during the week before the Championships.
Timing:	Electronic Timing and Hy-tek Meet Manager software will be used.



Withdrawals:	Withdrawals should be made by email by 5pm Thursday 12 th October 2023 – no refunds will be given for withdrawals.
Facilities:	Parking is available at the venue. A pool will be available for warm up and cool down throughout the event.
Enquiries:	All enquiries should be sent by email only to <u>munsterentries@swimireland.ie</u> Entry reports and further information will be posted on the Swim Munster website before the start of the gala – <u>www.swimmunster.ie</u>
Selections:	 Irish Minor Schools Swimming Championships – 23rd March 2024 – NAC Dublin Swimmers can qualify for the Irish Minor Schools Championships 2024 at the Swim Munster Schools Championships 2023. Qualifying swimmers will be marked on the results sheets posted at the event. The qualifying times for the Irish Minor Schools Swimming Championships are attached at the back of these meet conditions. Entry for the Irish Minor Schools will be online. A link will be provided for all qualifying swimmers. The running of finals is dependant upon available time. If number of entries is excessive, it may be necessary to go to Heat Declared Winners. This will be communicated in advance of the meet.

100 IM Super Final Girls – 11 year old Superfinal: the top 10 swimmers combined points across all the individual events (max 4) swam by each swimmer will compete for the 100 im superfinal (one final for each gender and age group). Points are calculated by the Meet Manager software based on the placing of the swimmer in each event.

In the event of a tie for 10th place, a swim off will take place between the relevant swimmers over 50m Freestyle heat until a winner is declared.

The skin race stages alternate between boys and girls per each age group as follows

Stage 1: all the swimmers qualified are competing. The distance is 50 meters and the stroke is drawn by the competition manager; the first 8 proceed to stage 2. Girls race and boys race.

Stage 2: the remaining 8 swimmers are competing. The distance is 50 meters and the stroke is drawn by the competition manager (among the 3 remaining); the first 6 proceed to stage 3. Girls race and boys race.

Stage 3: the remaining 6 swimmers are competing. The distance is 50 meters and the stroke is drawn by the competition manager (among the 2 remaining); the first 4 proceed to stage 4. Girls race and boys race.

Stage 4: the remaining 4 swimmers are competing. The distance is 50 meters and the stroke is the last remaining not previously swum in stage 1-2-3; the first 2 proceed to stage 5. Girls race and boys race.



Stage 5: the remaining 2 swimmers are competing. The distance is 50 meters and the is drawn by the competition manager (among all the 4 strokes); the winner is the overall winner of the event.

4x25/50/75/100m Freestyle Mixed Relay: Each Team must have 2 boys and 2 girls (13&Over); each team swims the 4 distances in the specific order: one 25 - one 50 - one 75 - one 100. The order of the swimmers (boys or girls first) is free.

Points for Clubs re Hosting Munster Galas, Applying for Meet Licence etc.

Hosting a Future Challenger Meet

On three of the four Future Challenger dates, the Meets will be held in clubs in the Region (2 clubs each holding an event on the designated weekend). Two venues for each Future Challenger will be required, ideally at opposite locations in the region, to allow for an equal division of participating clubs. The final Future Challenger will be held in UL.

For Future Challengers hosted by Clubs – Swim Munster will:

- Pay for the hire of the Pool for the day.
- Provide the Timing Equipment, however the host club will need to arrange collection of & return of equipment with the Munster Treasurer.
- Provide qualified Swim Ireland officials to run the meet.

The Host Club will:

- Book the venue and liaise with the facility for all aspects of the gala. Venue to be booked for the full day, with sole use for the FC gala.
- Provide a representative to liaise with Swim Munster for the purposes of organising the FC gala.
- Provide officials to operate the Timing Suite, ie., Electronic Timing & Recorder. Training will be provided by Swim Ireland for the Recorder position and clubs should endeavour to have at least one club member attend the course.
- If host clubs are having difficulty providing Timing Officials, please revert to the Munster Executive who will help out in this transition period.
- Provide Call Room officials.
- Print Programmes all proceeds from sale of programmes will remain with host club.
- Control of Photography Log & announcements re no photography on pool deck.
- Provide PA System. If this is not available at the pool, then it may be hired and clubs may submit the Invoice to the Munster Treasurer for reimbursement.
- Provide Stop Watches, Clipboards & Pens
- Paper, Tally Roll & Ink Cartridge (Invoice for same may be sent to Munster Treasurer for reimbursement).
- Provide lunch for Swim Ireland Officials. (This can be sandwiches & cake supplied by club parents, with Tea/Coffee).

Participating Clubs will:

• Provide officials for all other posts (1:6 up to a max of 4 per session).

Clubs looking to host Invitational Galas, particularly Level 3 galas will be expected to host at least one Future Challenger, as a condition of sanction for Invitational requests in the 2023/2024 season. This requirement will remain in place. However, it is expected that Swim Ireland will increase the number of required officials for Level 3 galas in the following season.



Applying for an Invitational Gala - Level 3

Clubs will be expected to host a Future Challenger Meet in order to be considered for a Level 3 Licence.

Ideally, these should all be applied for at the Clubs Meeting so that they can be entered on the Regional Calendar, thus allowing clubs throughout the region an opportunity to plan their programmes. However, if all 6 have not been applied for at the Clubs meeting, there will be leniency with late applications, provided there is a vacancy on the calendar and the application meets the requirements of the Regional Pathway Committee.

The increase to 6, is to allow for greater LC opportunity and clubs should consider booking UL for a day to host a Level 3 gala. This would provide further opportunity to swimmers, to qualify for National events, in LC meets.

There will be a max of 6 Level 3 Galas sanctioned in the region in the 2023/2024 season.

- Part 1 of Licence Application must be submitted to <u>meetlicencingmunster@swimireland.ie</u> as soon as possible after being granted by the region, but at least 3 months prior to date of gala.
- Part 1 <u>must be accompanied</u> by copy of Meet Conditions, outlining Qualification criteria and Event Schedule.
- On receipt of Part 1, the application is forwarded to the Regional Pathway Committee, who will review Qualification criteria and Event Schedule. If they have any queries, they will revert to the Club, otherwise, if all in order, they will return to the Meet Licencing Official who will check that the Meet Conditions comply with Licence requirements, e.g., Ages for eligible swimmers. If all is in order, a Provisional Licence will be issued.
- The Provisional Licence number should be listed on all documentation relating to the Gala, as it will provide proof that the Gala has been sanctioned and will be covered by Swim Ireland Insurance.
- Part 2 of the Licence Application should be submitted to the Meet Licencing Official as soon as possible after the closing date for receipt of entries, but at a minimum, 10 days prior to the date of the gala.
- Part 2 should be accompanied by a Session Report.
- The Meet Licencing Official will review the documentation to ensure that the required number of officials have been confirmed as attending. Officials may be asked to confirm their availability. The Meet Licencing Official will also check that the Session Report indicates that the gala will comply with the 8 hour per day criteria. (If there are medal presentations, these must fall within the 8 hour criteria. Time for Warm Up is outside of the 8 hour criteria). They will also check that the minimum heat interval, as stipulated by Swim Ireland has been applied.
- If everything is in order, the Meet Licencing Official will advise that the Licence Number is confirmed.
- After the Gala, Part 3 of the Licence Application, i.e., Referee Report & Checklist, together with a full copy of the Meet Results must be submitted to the Meet Licencing Official within 14 days of the competition.

Applying for Level 1 or Level 2 Invitational Galas

There will be no limit on the number of Level 1 or Level 2 Galas during the season, as these are fundraising opportunities for our clubs.

Ideally, these should all be applied for at the Clubs Meeting so that they can be entered on the Regional Calendar, thus allowing clubs throughout the region an opportunity to plan their programmes. However, as there will be no limit on the number available, the only limiting factor will be availability on the regional calendar.



- Part 1 of Licence Application must be submitted to <u>meetlicencingmunster@swimireland.ie</u> as soon as possible after being granted by the region, but at least 3 months prior to date of gala.
- Part 1 must be accompanied by copy of Meet Conditions, outlining Qualification criteria and Event Schedule.
- The Meet Licencing Official will check that the Meet Conditions comply with Licence requirements, eg., Ages for eligible swimmers. If all is in order, a Provisional Licence will be issued.
- The Provisional Licence number should be listed on all documentation relating to the Gala, as it will provide proof that the Gala has been sanctioned and will be covered by Swim Ireland Insurance.
- Part 2 of the Licence Application should be submitted to the Meet Licencing Official as soon as possible after the closing date for receipt of entries, but at a minimum, 10 days prior to the date of the gala.
- Part 2 should be accompanied by a Session Report.
- The Meet Licencing Official will review the documentation to ensure that the required number of officials have been confirmed as attending. Officials may be asked to confirm their availability. Closing Dates for Entries to Munster Meets

These dates are DEADLINES, not TARGETS. We have extended the closing date out to as close to the Meet Date as possible. In return, we ask Clubs to help by submitting their entries on time, to allow the Recorder sufficient time to enter all on the Hy-tek file and prepare Session Reports & Psych Sheets etc.

The Munster Executive must also adhere to all the Meet Licencing requirements for regional galas, so Session Reports (which can only be prepared after receipt of all entries, must, as is also the case with club invitationals, be submitted to the Meet Licencing 10 days before the gala). If we work together, anything is possible.

Relay Entries

Please adhere to the DEADLINES (not TARGETS) for Relay entries, particularly at our Munster SC & LC Championships. There is extra pressure on the Recorder at these meets. The reason being that swimmers are given a 30 minute period after the results are announced, during which time they can withdraw from a final and allow a reserve to be put in to the final. As a result, the Start Sheets for finals cannot be printed until that 30 minute period has expired and all finalists have been confirmed

Club Slots on Official Rotas for all Munster Meets

We respectively ask for support from our clubs with regard to the Official Rota at all Munster Meets. Swim Munster will ensure that all key posts, Referee, Starter, Stroke Judges, Timing Official, Recorder, Competition Manager, Technical Delegate and Announcer will be filled by qualified Volunteer Officials.



We need a team of 37 officials to run a competition. We cannot do this without the help from the clubs. We have reduced the number of officials from 20 to 10 at the Start End to help alleviate pressure on our clubs.

Every effort is made to ensure that the requirement on clubs is distributed as fairly as possible, with the largest clubs asked to provide the greater number of officials. There is a requirement listed on every set of Meet Conditions that Clubs are asked to provide 1 per 6 swimmers, per session, up to a max of 4 officials per session.

The rota is populated using the Session Report with List of Clubs attending and # of swimmers per club. We also use the Psych Sheets to try to determine which clubs will have swimmers in the final sessions.

If a club is allocated a position that they feel they cannot fill, then it is the responsibility of the club to arrange a swop with another club.

We appreciate that the evening sessions are difficult, as parents want to leave when their children are finished. However, if everyone adopted that attitude, then we would not have sufficient quota of officials to run the meet.

'White & Black' officials work as Munster officials and are over and above the Club allocation. Where possible, we do try to make an allowance for these officials, but it is not always possible.

Meet Mobile

Meet Mobile will be available at all future Munster Galas. It is recommended that all clubs looking to host Level 3 Galas should also provide Meet Mobile.
